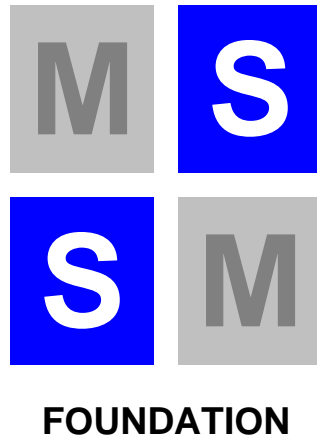

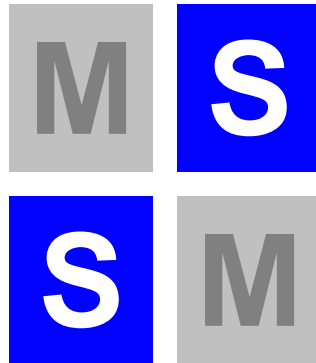

From the MSSM Foundation


On behalf of the MSSM Foundation, I would like to thank the MSSM community of staff, alumni, parents and friends who have contributed to this past year's fund raising initiatives. In particular, I want to recognize the efforts of Dory Streett who did an outstanding job chairing the 2006-07 annual giving campaign! I am thrilled to announce that Dory has graciously agreed to lead this year's campaign, as well.

By working together, we have raised almost \$116,000 in the 2006-2007 school year. Nearly \$80,000 dollars were committed to fund student room and board costs for the lower income families. Also funded were projects such as team support for student research opportunities at Acadia National Park , studying mathematics at King's College and British History at Oxford University, a group attended an international technology conference in Hawaii, and a faculty member, along with several MSSM students, attended a student leadership forum at the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics.

Through Walt Warner's leadership, the MSSM has been successful in creating a funding mechanism which for the first time has our state legislature contributing toward room and board costs for families in need. This means that funds raised this year can now be used to address equipment issues such as improved air handling for our chemistry lab(s), additional software and hardware computer updates, more faculty development opportunities, increased funding of additional high interest courses and educational seminars for the MSSM student body.

Please join me in making the MSSM Foundation one of your charitable donation priorities during the 2007-2008 school year. Our contributions do matter and allow for a margin of excellence at MSSM.
