

Packing Information

– Necessary Items

- Roll of Quarters for washer & dryer (\$3 per load)
- Alarm clock
- Computer (integrated or external web cam a nice option for “calls” home via video Instant Messaging) ~ check with your insurance agent ... some companies waive any deductible for loss or damage to computers, cameras, etc. which have been itemized on your homeowner’s policy
- Printer
- Ream of paper
- 10-15 ft. Ethernet cable or wireless card
- 2, 4 or 8 G Pen drive/Flash drive
- Surge Protector/Power strip
- Comfortable office chair (optional ... a desk and a chair are provided)
- Graphing calculator (TI-83 or TI-84 – but refer to list from math teachers)
- Laundry bag/basket
- Laundry detergent
- Personal toiletry items
- Pillow, sheets (extra long twin), blankets, 2 bath towels, 2 hand towels
- School supplies – refer to detailed list from Academic Dean
- Plastic Hangers
- Refillable water bottle

– Helpful Items

- Books for pleasure reading
- Dorm room wall decorations, pushpins/white poster putty
- MP3/iPod/Personal Digital music device
- Bike Helmet/Skateboard safety gear/other sports gear
- Small fan
- Study lamp
- Cordless phone with answering machine with 10-15 ft. wall cord
- Cell phone
- Small dorm room refrigerator (Max. 3.6 Cu. Ft)
- Small drying rack for towels/laundry
- Small wastebasket
- Pillow top or foam mattress pad
- Under-bed storage box
- Bed leg risers
- Microwave safe bowl, plate & utensils
- Bathing suit - one piece required for girls (there is a pool at the school)
- In January – skis, snow shoes, extra blanket, flannel sheet, warmer clothes

– Please do not bring these items:

- Cleaning products
- Iron/ironing board
