

Looking for Summer Work?

Consider teaching at MSSM Summer Camp

The Basics:

Four weeks in beautiful Limestone in Aroostook County, teaching 4 classes per day (2 different ones twice a day). Work hours are 8:30 AM to around 3 PM. Three meals a day plus a dorm room are included. Camp starts June 23rd (check in for campers), but instructors would need to be on campus Saturday, June 22nd. Camp ends at noon on July 20th.

Salary:

Instructors are paid \$1,000 a week. This can be a paper check or direct deposit. Paydays are the 2nd and 4th Friday.

Duties:

Teach 4 classes to a maximum of 15 middle school-aged campers Monday through Friday. In most cases, it is 2 different classes each taught twice, but occasionally one class becomes so popular, we ask it be taught 3 times. In the evenings we have various activities that instructors are encouraged to join, but not required.

Classes:

Classes are 65 minutes long. There is a materials budget for supplies which are ordered before camp starts. Instructors usually propose 4 class ideas in March and we choose 2. We provide a total of \$1,000 one time for all class materials. Limited resupply during camp in cases of a change in the number of classes.

Accommodations:

We offer a double dorm room for each instructor. In certain cases, we can accommodate full families, but space is limited. From check-in day for staff through check-out time at the end of camp, 3 meals a day are provided as well as various snacks. There is also free laundry, a full dorm kitchen, and lounge areas. The town has a grocery store, but Caribou and Presque Isle are 15 min and 30 min away. Instructors are free to leave campus after classes and on weekends. After the initial staff training, Instructors' duties are mostly Monday through Friday. The one exception is presenting your class to all campers in the dining hall on Sunday evenings when they make their class decisions.
